

Pew Dedications – Preserving our Sanctuary

The generations of members and friends that came before us made it possible for us worship in our beautiful sanctuary today. As we look forward, we need to help ensure that our sanctuary will be preserved for future generations. One opportunity to do this that will also leave an enduring mark is through a pew dedication.

Individual members, families, groups and friends can dedicate a favorite pew or another pew in the sanctuary with an inscribed plaque as a memorial to a loved one, to honor a particular person, or simply naming the person or persons dedicating the pew.

The bronze plaque measures 7-1/2" w by 2-1/2" h. If you look at pews #s 22, #71 and #78, you will see examples from prior dedicated members.

Each plaque will cost \$10,000 and proceeds from their sale will be placed in a special fund for the preservation of our beloved sanctuary and the enhancement of worship activities. Use of the funds received will be under the sole discretion of the Senior Pastor.

These dedications will be a meaningful way to express our gratitude for the many decades that this sacred space has been a place of worship and hospitality.
